United Learning is a group of schools which aims to provide excellent education to children and young people across the country. United Learning seek to improve the life chances of all the children and young people they serve and to bring out the best in 'everyone' – students, staff, parents and the wider community. Uniquely, the Group includes significant numbers of schools in both the public and private sectors, working together for mutual benefit.

United Learning Trust was established in 1884, the Group has 97 sites from Sunderland to Shoreham and inspires over 30,000 children and employs over 5,500 staff across the UK.

APS Consulting were asked by United Learning to review the current consumption and energy procurement strategy. The team identified a range of objectives in order to improve the energy management approach.

The first step was to identify where savings could be made in their gas and electricity contracts by reviewing the current renewal quote and gaining alternative pricing options from key suppliers. Rob Moore, Account Manager at Utilitywise, was able to identify a considerable saving on both electricity and gas and offer United Learning value for money on their energy contracts by employing a Group buying consortium approach.

Utilitywise was also able to recover charges made to United Learning's portfolio for 'out of contract' rates and arrange common end dates for all meters in the group, resulting in a more streamlined energy management protocol across the 97 sites.

A range of energy and water solutions are also being deployed to allow United Learning to benefit from Utilitywise' broad portfolio of energy monitoring and consumption-reduction services. Energy Audits are initially being conducted at eight schools within the Group. This is a full review of each school within the pilot group identified with a view to identifying areas where the schools can derive energy savings through the deployment of energy-saving technologies and behavioural change.

In order to offer an advanced energy monitoring system, Utilitywise is also deploying its unique Edd:e metering solution to two schools, providing them with an in-depth understanding of energy usage by monitoring every circuit. Finally, water audits and water bill validation is being conducted at one of the schools based in Bognor Regis; over time, Utilitywise will roll-out this service to the remaining 96 sites in the Group's portfolio.
